THE 2023 POTTERY GUILD SALE TO BENEFIT MANNA HOUSE

This year's fund raiser for Manna House will be held on March 8, 2023, at the Baptist Chapel from 1-4 p.m. And as in past years, it promises to be another huge success. Last year \$6,200.00 was raised! Can we top this? WE CAN TRY!

The event is sponsored by the Jekyll Island Arts Association's Pottery Guild. The potters have been busy for months making beautiful pieces - bowls of many sizes, turtles, bird houses, butter dishes, vases and other unique creations in clay.

The large room at the Baptist Chapel is the ideal setting for a safe event. Tables will be spaced to allow for social distancing. And attendance will be staggered throughout the afternoon.

Each \$20.00 ticket holder will be able to chose one piece of pottery. There will also be additional pieces available for sale. Tickets may be purchased at the front desk at Goodyear Cottage, at the various churches, and from community members: Skip Adamson, Bob Cauthen, Jane Sarcona, Jo Anne Buisson, Mary Perkins, and Barbara Poloncic, as well as from members of the Pottery Guild. And as always, if you wish to make an additional monetary contribution, make a check out to Manna House and give it to a member of the Manna House team: Tim and Gretchen Sharlow, Dave and Shirley Palmer, Carla Price, Norm and Lesley Hughes, and Jim and Janice Talada.

As an additional attraction this year, there will be ongoing pottery demonstrations in tents on the lawn outside the Chapel

Manna House, located at 1408 G Street in Brunswick, was established in 1983 as a 501C3 non profit charity by local business leaders and clergy out of their concern for the homeless and the hungry. Manna House continues to serve close to 300 meals, 7 days a week, year round. The workers are volunteers and all funding is from donations only. JIAA ARTS FESTIVAL March 10, 11 & 12, 2023

Friday 12 noon - 5 pm Saturday 10 am - 5:00 Sunday 10am - 4pm

The Jekyll Island Arts Festival offers all members of the JIAA the opportunity to share their art in demonstrations, sales, and by having the artwork judged during the Juried show.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: JURIED ARTWORK

Registration opens January 20 and closes February 28.

Intake: Saturday, March 4, 12 noon- 4 p.m. Sunday, March 5, 9am to 12 pm

Any artist who has been a member of the Jekyll Island Arts Association for at least 3 months is eligible to submit work for the "juried art show" at the Arts Festival in 2023.

REGISTERING ARTWORK FOR THE JURIED SHOW

Exhibitors must **pre-register** their entries on their **personal member page on the JIAA web-site.** On-line registration will open January 20, 2023, and close February 28, 2023.

Sales/ID tags will be printed on Monday and Thursday mornings during February. They will be placed in your shop folder. If you do not have a shop folder one will be labeled with your name and placed with the shop folders in the Goodyear kitchen. The final day for printing tags will be March 1. Please pick up your sales/ID tags and place them on the back or bottom of your artwork prior to check-in day. Wall art ID tags should be placed on the lower right corner of the back. Also, people purchasing art appreciate a business card or a bio of the artist. These must be attached to the back prior to check-in.

GENERAL CRITERIA FOR ALL JURIED ARTWORK

Each artist may submit a total of ONE item that is not-for-sale (NFS.)

Juried artwork may be photographed. Photos of ribbon winning artwork may be displayed on the JIAA website. Images may be used in future JIAA Advertising.

All juried artwork will remain on display through March 29, if not sold and removed by purchaser or artist. All juried artwork must be picked up after 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 29th or between 9:00 a.m. and 12 noon on Wednesday, March 30th.

Entries **shall not** have been exhibited in any previous juried JIAA gallery exhibit, Festival, or have been for sale in the Goodyear Gallery shop.

All work must be clean, undamaged, and ready for display. This includes mats and frames.

FOUR SKILL LEVELS TO BE JUDGED: Artists decide their appropriate level.

NOVICE: Artist just learning the art, usually taking beginning classes.

INTERMEDIATE: Artist with some experience, perhaps taking intermediate classes, comfortable in their chosen art form or medium.

ADVANCED: Artist capable, experienced, and confident in art. May be teaching. May be in shows and galleries. May sell their work. May have demonstrated success in competition.

PROFESSIONAL: Artist who sell their work. Have developed their own distinctive and effective style. Self-motivated. Experiments with different styles and/or techniques. Recognized in their field as a professional.

PRICING

Pricing is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please use even dollar amounts. Pricing is before tax.

25% commission will be collected on items sold and 75% paid to exhibitor in April.

ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED IN 8 CATEGORIES:

Painting:

Sub-categories: Watercolor, acrylic, oil, encaustic, ink brush-painting, pastels, mixed media (**obvious** combination of painting, attached material or collage items rather than one medium.)

A maximum of 3 entries.

No size restrictions **except** large items **must** be able to be carried by one person.

Paintings must be ready to hang, with wire attached. (No saw tooth hangers will be accepted because our hanging system will not accommodate them.)

Please wrap the wire ends with tape to protect the people handling the art and, also the walls.

No unframed canvases unless sides are finished and have no staples showing.

No Glecee prints of paintings.

No wet paint or varnish.

Drawing:

Sub-categories: Charcoal, pencil, colored pencils, pen and ink, prints (wood cut, lino-cut, etc.) Zentangle framed.

A maximum of 3 entries.

No size restrictions except large items must be able to be carried by one person.

Drawings must be ready to hang, with wire attached. (No saw tooth hangers will be accepted because our hanging system will not accommodate them.)

Please wrap the wire ends with tape to protect the people handling the art and, also the walls.

No unframed artwork in the drawing category.

Original artwork only no prints other than those listed above.

Photography:

Sub-categories: Nature, Landscape, and Open. Open includes but is not limited to: Architectural, People, Macro, Alternative (extensively manipulated), and Astro. A maximum of 3 photos.

No size restrictions except large items must be able to be carried by one person.

Photos must be ready to hang, with wire attached. (No saw tooth hangers will be accepted because our hanging system will not accommodate them.)

Please wrap the wire ends with tape to protect the people handling the art and, also the walls.

Fiber Arts:

Sub-categories: Weaving, Quilting, Art Quilting, Fashion and Fabric accessory design, Needle Arts (These are: Embroidery, Needlepoint, Cross Stitch, Hooked Rugs, Knitting-Crocheting)

A maximum of 4 total entries.

Quilts have no size restrictions, but will be folded for display

Pottery:

Sub-categories: Wheel-thrown, Hand-built, Raku

A maximum of 6 pieces with limit of 2 in any one subcategory.

Pottery must have a smooth finish on the bottom and have protective pads attached.

Sculpture:

Includes carving, modeling, casting, and/or assembling into a 3D form.

A maximum total of three entries.

Large items, (weight and size) must be able to be carried by one person.

Heritage Arts:

Sub-categories: Basketry, Woodworking, Metalwork

A maximum total of 4 entries

Large items must be able to be carried by one person.

All Metalwork must be able to be carried by one person.

Handmade Arts:

Sub-categories: Jewelry, Beading, Shell-craft, Glass Craft, Paper Craft, three-dimensional items decorated with Zentangle.

A maximum of 4 total entries

Ribbons: Entrants will compete for first, second, and third place and honorable mention ribbons. Jurors will determine the number of awards in each category, sub-category, and skill lev

el as well as the number of honorable mention ribbons distributed. It is at the Judges sole discretion in awarding a ribbon in any category, sub-category, and skill level.

Note: At their discretion, judges or festival organizers may agree to reassign artwork into a more appropriate category or skill level for judging purposes and may combine categories if there are insufficient entries.

IN-TAKE OF ARTWORK FOR THE JURIED SHOW

Intake: Saturday, March 4, 12 noon- 4 pm Sunday, March 5, 9am to 12 pm

To help keep in-take moving smoothly and quickly, please place ID/sales tags on the back or bottom of your artwork prior to check-in day. Wall art ID tags should be placed on the lower right corner of the back. Do not bring any artwork that is not pre-registered and does not have an ID/price tag.

Intake will be set up at the corner of the north and south walkways behind Goodyear Cottage. Signs will indicate where to bring the different media. Intake volunteers will have your inventory list and tags for the juried show. They will check what you have brought against what you entered and cross off anything you decided not to bring. You will attach the show tags to the proper pieces of artwork.

Parking will be available in the Goodyear lot and on the grass along the north-south walkway. Carts and volunteer helpers will be available.

INTAKE FOR SHOP ITEMS

If you would like to bring items for the shop when bringing items for the juried show, they must be pre-registered with sales tags attached. Regular shop guidelines are in place for the festival. Limits are three wall pieces, ten pieces in total.

VOLUNTEERING

It takes many volunteers to put on the festival and make it possible for you to participate in the juried show. We ask all exhibitors to volunteer, or designate a volunteer, for at least 1 shift during festival or during festival set up week or take down. Please use the volunteer signup portal on the JIAA web site, in advance, to secure the volunteer position and shift of your choice. If you have not signed up in advance, you will be asked to sign up on check-in day.

Liability: All work is entered at the artist's risk. JIAA cannot assume responsibility for loss or damage during the festival. Due care will be taken in handling all work. Artwork remaining after March 30 becomes the property of the JIAA and may be used for fund raising activities.
